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I. Definition of a Miracle

After a good, almost an hour morning walk in this Nagar Van, in this south Indian town where we were on an official tour, we sat on the stairs of this half garden half temple, actually, a garden with sculptors of few deities. Our discussion started towards our experience of slowly evolving through the paths we have adopted. She is following the path of 'Japa' i.e. Chanting while I am following 'Kriya' i.e. working on inner geometry (in simple words). Her friend is not from a very strong financial background and one day her father-in-law had a severe heart attack and she used all her savings in the initial treatment of father in law. But some complications arise and the father in law has to be operated upon for which she has to arrange approximately Rs. 5 lakhs immediately. She was completely broke by that time and had no clue from where to arrange the money. She has lost all hopes of arranging the money. However, on reaching the hospital, she was called in by the Director of the hospital to inform that the surgery will be performed free of cost for some reason which I do not remember correctly. It was nothing short of a miracle for her and yes it is a miracle for which she is very thankful to the path she is following.

I agree with the power of prayer as through the prayer, whether you are invoking your inner powers or repenting for your past deeds or just trying to find the way ahead, in any way you are sort of slowly addressing your Karma. Being aware of that is important.

But why I am sharing this story is down here.

Then during the day, I was with another colleague of mine, discussing random things when the discussion turned towards, how he faced a similar situation and how efficiency of governance saved a life. For a few days during that time, his brother had to go out of the country for some official work and that is when his father got a heart attack. 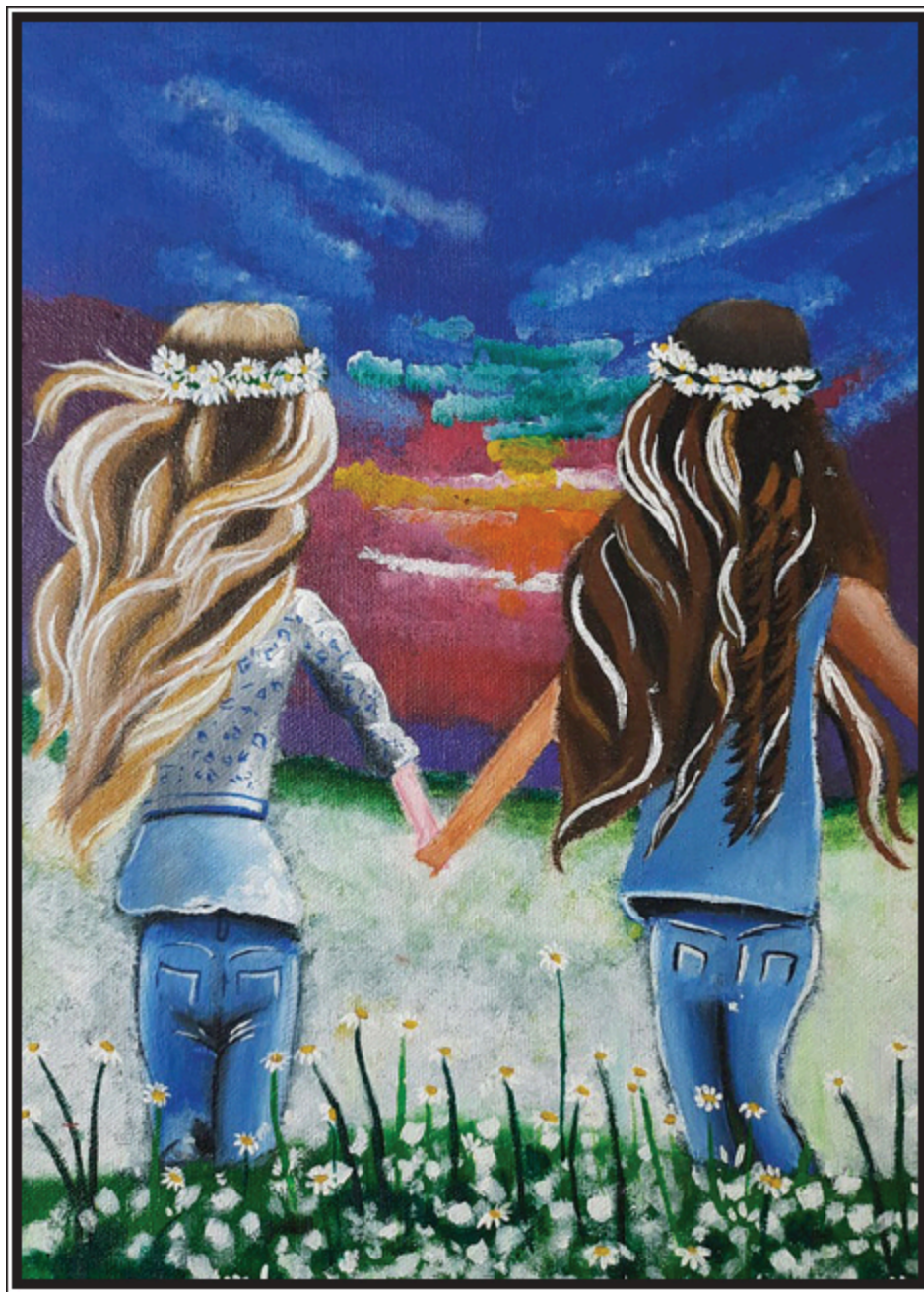

(if at ease then its just pain..... if not then its love...)

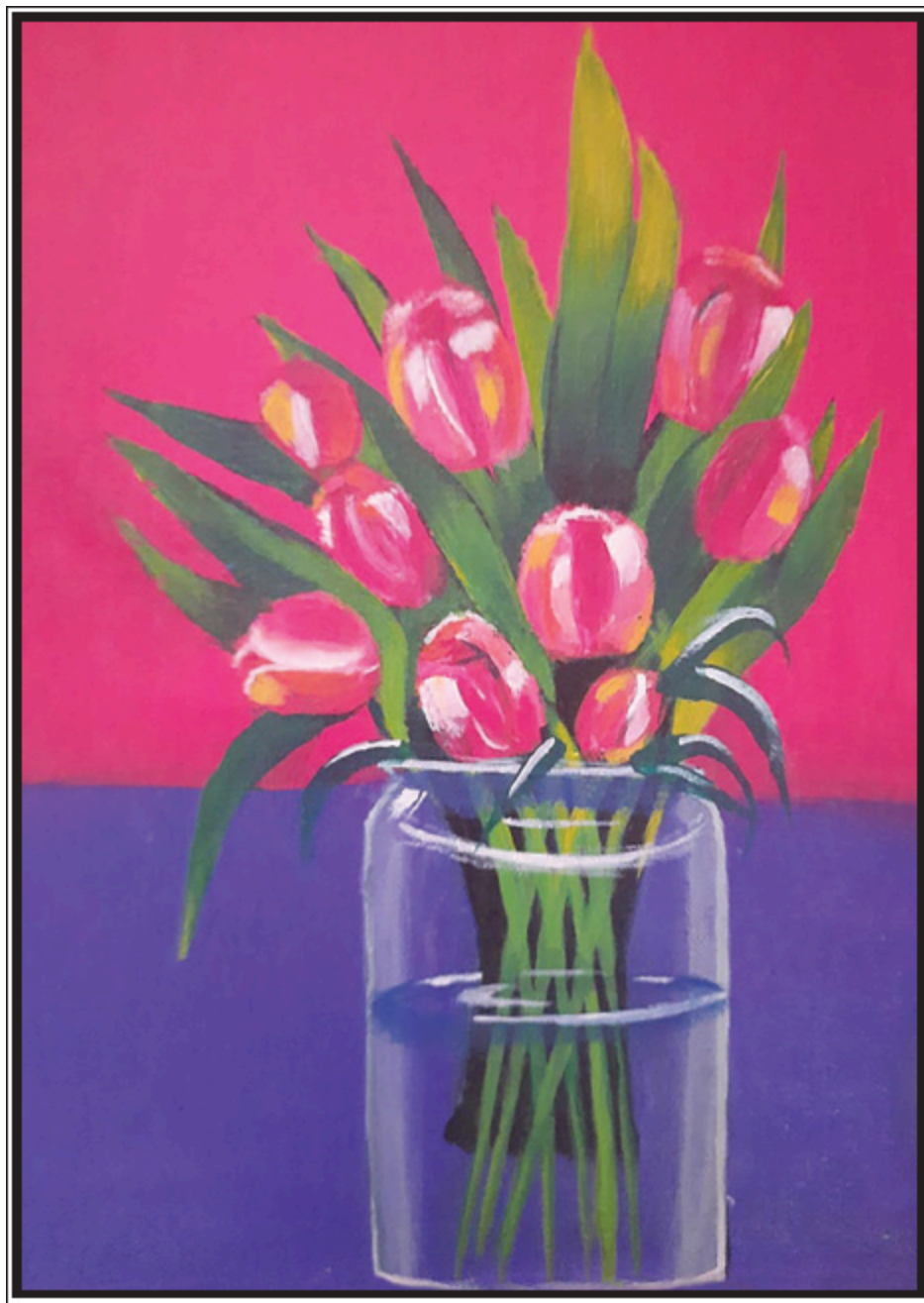
He thinks for a bit and then the new born whimpers.

However, now as I think about it, Chana or Chhola is still not that visible but Potato is so much more visible and yet it is not the most versatile. Why So? Simply, because we have mortgaged our intellect to google.

Now coming back to my initial thought about the education system.
